Aloe Vera

Aloe barbadensis

- Known for its healing properties, aloe is used for everything from skin hydration to immune support.
- The clear gel found inside the leaves is most commonly used for minor cuts and burns.
- Tough, fleshy, spear like leaves can grow up to 36" long.

Angelica

Angelica archangelica

- Tall growing biennial with long, spindle-shaped, bright green deeply lobed, fleshy foliage.
- Small, yellowish-green flowers in midsummer. Very aromatic, slight celery-flavor.
- Seeds can be used as sweetener & leaves in salads; roots are often used medicinally.

Anise

Pimpinella anisum

- An annual, herbaceous plant with finely-leaved foliage and small white flowers in midsummer.
- Primarily associated with cakes, biscuits, and confectionery, as well as rye bread.
- Components of anise are known to have calming effects that can relieve anxiety and nervousness.

Bloom Time: Mid to Late Summer

Anise – Hyssop

Agastache foeniculum

- Vigorous erect herb with anise-scented spikes of blue flowers in late summer.
- Edible flowers that can be used to sweeten tea or to flavor sugar, quick breads, or muffins.
- Leaves are said to have antibacterial properties and can be used to alleviate coughs and colds.

Artemisia – Cola Plant

Artemisia arbotanum 'Cola Plant'

- Woody stems forming a 3-4' tall mound of ferny, strongly aromatic, medium to light green leaves.
- Works well along paths as a border or low hedge.
- Young leaves can be used to flavor drinks, in salads, or used in cooking stews and roast meats.

Arugula

Eruca sativa

- Dark green, tender, peppery flavored leaves; edible flowers.
- Add the flowers to your salads and stir-fry's; leaves are great in salads.
- Leaves tend to taste better prior to the plant flowering.

Arugula – Wasabi

Diplotaxis erucoides

- Wasabi Arugula has green toothed, spoon-shaped leaves.
- The flowers are edible too, however, after it flowers, the leaves tend to develop a sharper taste.
- Slight bitterness, horseradish, and pepper aromatics, more peppery than other arugula varieties.

Bachelor's Buttons (Cornflower)

Centaurea cyanus

- Prolific bloomer with flowers in blue, pink, lavender, white and maroon.
- Flowers are best used fresh as an edible garnish as they are only lightly fragrant with minimal flavor.
- Bachelors buttons resemble tiny carnations with pointed papery petals.

Basil - African Blue

Ocimum 'Kasar'

- This hybrid forms an upright mound of attractive blue-green leaves with pink-purple flowers.
- Use fresh leaves to give additional color and slightly different taste to salads.
- The leaves are purple when young, growing green as they grow to full size and retain purple veins.

Bloom Time: Mid Summer to Late Fall

Basil - Amethyst Improved

Ocimum basilicum 'Amethyst Imp.'

- Well-branched mound of large, purple-black aromatic leaves with a sweet, spicy flavor.
- Large leaves are down turned at the edges with color ranging from dark burgundy to almost black.
- Used the same way you use regular Genovese, its unique color lends itself to colorful combinations.

Basil - Aromatto

Ocimum basilicum 'Aromatto'

- Beautiful purple flower bracts, purple-green leaves, and strong, purple stems.
- Scent is similar to cinnamon basil. It has a spicy flavor, but is sweeter tasting than Genovese basil.
- The color and scent make this basil ideal to use as a filler accent in cut-flower bouquets.

Basil - Bouquet Mix

Ocimum basilicum

- Color variety makes this basil an attractive option for planting.

- Beneficial in gardens because they discourage bugs from damaging plants.

Basil - Coldasil

Ocimum Basilicum 'Coldasil'

- Vigorous, bushy grower with dark green, medium size leaves, remove flowers in order to promote leaf production.
- This aromatic herb is great in the kitchen and adds unique flavor to many recipes.
- Less sensitive to cold and able to tolerate temperatures around 50 degrees Fahrenheit.

Basil – Dolce Fresca

- Like most basil it is known to soothe upset stomachs and aid in relieving other discomfort.
- When other basil gets tall and leggy, Dolce Fresca holds a controlled size and remains mounded and tidy.

- Flowers late in the season, large harvests of leaves throughout Summer
- The traditional Genovese flavor is perfect for eating fresh in caprese salad or chopped fresh in recipes.

Basil – Everleaf Genovese

- Robust Genovese flavour is perfect for pesto and adding to sauce.
- Well-branched tidy plant that performs well for garden or container planting.

Basil – Everleaf Thai Towers

- Plants are very upright with purple stems and densely packed, dark green leaves with a purple bluish.
- Late-flowering habit means huge harvests of flavorful leaves throughout Summer.

Basil – Genovese

Ocimum basilicum 'Genovese'

- Wrinkled dark green leaves with an aroma similar to cloves.

Basil – Genovese Red

- Same aroma and flavor to traditional Genovese but with a kick of color.

Basil – Greek Columnar

- This basil is unusually tall for a basil but remains quite thin, giving it a "column-like" appearance.

- Lush green foliage topped by red-purple flowers in late Summer and a strong tall upright growth habit.
- Fragrant flowers are highly attractive to bees, butterflies, and/or birds.

- Full mostly dark green leaves with toothed edges and a reddish hue.
- Its pink flowers are highly attractive to bees, butterflies, and/or birds.

Basil – Kapoor Tulsi

Ocimum americanum var. *pilosum*

- The Kapoor variety is the best Tulsi basil for temperate gardens. Leaves can be used to make herbal tea.
- Also known as Holy Basil, it is very aromatic with a unique, spicy aroma with hints of coffee and chocolate.
- Also used as an immune-enhancing, antifungal, and antibacterial medicinal herb.

Basil – Lime

Ocimum basilicum 'Lime'

- A distinct zesty lime flavor and aroma, yet still a discernible basil taste.
- Flowers bloom at the tops of the branches in large spikes of small white flowers.

Basil - Mrs. Burns

Ocimum basilicum 'Mrs. Burns'

- Also has undertones of cinnamon and hints of spice along with the floral note.
- Bright green, slightly serrated leaves and white flowers that are tinged with pink.

Basil - Pesto Perpetuo

- Unsurprisingly, it'd make a great pesto as the leaves have the distinct smell of basil with a hint of lemon.

- The eye-catching purple foliage is a surprising filler that looks stunning in pots and border beds.

- Very traditional in flavor but sweeter in aroma to other basil.

- Establishes faster than Rutgers Obsession, with uniform, upright growth and dark green flat to cup-shaped leaves.
- Allows for many harvests over growing season.

**Basil - Rutgers Obsession (DMR)**

- A high leaf-to-stem ratio – good for small bunches or small size clamshells.

**Basil - Rutgers Passion (DMR)**

- Slightly cupped leaves of a greater size compared to Rutgers Obsession.

- It makes a nice topiary and responds well to pruning. Dried leaves also make a nice herbal tea.

Bee Balm

Monarda didyma

- Can be used as an aromatherapy treatment to help soothe cold symptoms, sore throat, fever, and congestion.

- Can be used in soups, salads, lemonade, cocktails, preserves, jellies and various sauces.

- The flowers form in a rounded cluster of purple to pink tiny blooms.

- Caraway is an herb with fern-like leaves and white to pink flowers.

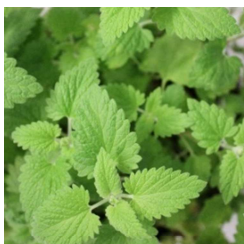
